- Allows us to easily access our handicap information, post scores, and view our handicap index established BY the USGA (NOT THE CLUB).
- Provides access to golf course information, including tee times, course ratings, and slope ratings.
- Allows us to view our handicap history, track our progress, and compare our scores with other golfers.
- Provides access to golf news, tips, and other resources.
- Available on both iOS and Android devices.

Monday through Saturday open: 12pm - 8pm, Sunday open: 12pm - 5pm.





Foundation News



In this newsletter, you have been witness to the positive initial results of the newly formed Kahgahgee Historical Golf Foundation. The immediate impact of course improvements made and, just as important, the tremendous success of the recent youth golf camp and league – teaching over 50 young kids how to play this wonderful lifelong sport.

This is all being made possible as a result of the 1892 Legacy Campaign going on **RIGHT NOW**. We are in the process of raising \$750,000 over the next 3 years to preserve, program and perpetuate our historical gem.

LET'S DO THIS!

2023 is a significant year of change for our historic course, the oldest continuously operated course West of Mississippi River!

We were able to achieve the unique status of a tax-exempt entity, having been granted a Section 501(c)(3) charitable organization by the Internal Revenue Service. We are now able to attract tax deductible donations from members and go after grants from outside groups to renovate and improve our beloved course. We have Jim Weaton to thank for engineering this process and Tim Kuiken for his tireless paperwork pushing to approval.

Due to the early generosity of some of our members, we have already jump started some much-needed improvements, most noticeably the cleaning up of KAHGAHGEE Creek. To give you some idea of the huge effort, over 50 dead and diseased trees were removed from the creek area and 55 stumps from around the course have been ground up. Tree canopies around several tees have been thinned to improve the health, especially by #3 and #4.


The latest project completed is the contouring of the creek bank by #'s 8, 9, and 2 and reinforced with over 600 tons of erosion control rock. **That's right, over six hundred tons!** This assures that the beauty of our creek area will be maintained for the long term. We all need to thank Larry Padget, our long-time course superintendent, for his supervision of the vendors and contractors.

One other unique project completed this spring, thanks to the coordination between Morgan Tree Service and Larry Bentler, is the inoculation of over 50 of our magnificent oaks & other hard wood trees. Some of you sharp-eyed golfers may notice quarter size aluminum tags stuck in some tree trunks along #'s 2,3, and 4 fairways. Those tags mark the trees that have been treated for oak wilt.

Projects for this fall and winter will include cart path renovations, tee improvements & bunker enhancements. The Foundation board invites all golf members to offer suggestions on ways to improve our course. These are some of the major projects & enhancements that have been undertaken... The Foundation has also been able to give Larry Padget and the Golf Committee, headed by Jason Davis, some additional funding for course maintenance and from the comments I've heard, our course is in the best condition it's been in for a long time.
