

Since February and in an effort to upgrade and improve our entire Club accounting systems, we have been involved in converting our old point of sale system to a new system called **Clover**. We believe that, once we complete the changeover, this will be an excellent long-term solution for the Club. We want to express our thanks for your patience as we have and continue to incur some unanticipated hiccups along the way. We are confident that we are a few weeks away from completing the project.

The new Clover system has a tremendous web-based interface with members. This interface will allow you to manage your account on-line and ultimately streamline detailed billing information for you and for our accounting team. **Be on the lookout for an e-mail in early May that will give you your personal link to your account.** This link will take you to your customer portal where you will be able to see all transactions you have at the Club, and you will be able to put in your credit card information and pay directly on-line. **Please Note:** due to updated security measures, we are ND LONGER able to charge your credit card on a monthly basis. You must use the link to pay directly or stop into the pro shop to run your credit card for your balance going forward.

Finally, we are aware of billing issues related to membership dues - many members have not been billed for dues and we believe we have isolated this issue going back to December of last year. **PLEASE**, if you know that you have not been billed, send an e-mail to <u>niki.pettit@weatoncompanies.com</u>. and we will look into the situation and attempt to rectify it as quickly as possible. Again, we are aware of the issue and are working extremely hard to resolve it as quickly as possible. A **HUGE** thank you for your patience with this matter - it was unforeseen and is a bit more complicated due to the Clover conversion. Again, thank you for your patience and commitment to helping us get this resolved.
